Thus, so as to fix this issue, outriggers could be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure in order to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. The crawler crane is unique in that it has large tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are really like backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction locations successfully.
